The Story

The day before his seventh birthday, Yuto dreams of the old man. When he wakes the box is open and Yuto finds a seed in the shape of a heart. He plants the seed and a tree begins to grow. Together, they grow up - A tale about listening with your heart and never being truly alone. About growing up and growing old, and about knowing when the time has come to go.

Logistics

Audience walks through the performance in groups of 6-10, depending on the size of the space. Time slots start every 10 minutes.

Full experience lasts 40 minutes (performance 30 minutes)

We can take up to 26 groups in a day, if we perform 10:30 - 16:30.

Capacity: 156-260 per day, depending on group size.

Requirements

Playing area: minimal 80m², optimal 130 m² (larger not a problem)

Space requirements: blacked out, rig in place (Tech rider available on request)

Floor: flat surface (set is on wheels)

Audience: immersive/walk-through so no seating required.

Build time: 1 day in a kitted out theatre

Break time: 2 hours
